THE GODFATHER TOUR

Visit the main locations of the Padrino movie. Have a coffee at the Bar Vitelli and visit the famous Padrino house - Castello degli Schiavi

Savoca is a small town of strong artistic and historical interest, surrounded by orange, almond and olive trees. The city preserves Medieval, Renaissance and Baroque remains and is famous for the crypt where the embalmed corpses of Savoca's upper - class notables from XVIII and XIX century are exhibited.

Savoca and Forza d'Agrò, were the locations for the scenes set in Corleone of Francis Ford Coppola's The Godfather.

Stop at Bar Vitelli and sit in the exact spot where Al Pacino informed Appollonia's father that his name was Michael Corleone and threatened him with an untimely death.

You will have the possibility to visit the famous Castello Degli Schiavi. A palace full of charm and beauty, which has been owned by the same family since it was built in the 17th century, and the present baron will give you a wonderful tour through the grounds.

The Castello is the place where a number of scenes from The Godfather trilogy were shot. This castle is the house where Michael lived during his exile, where his new wife Apollonia was murdered, and where Michael died alone in the courtyard at the end of Godfather III.
